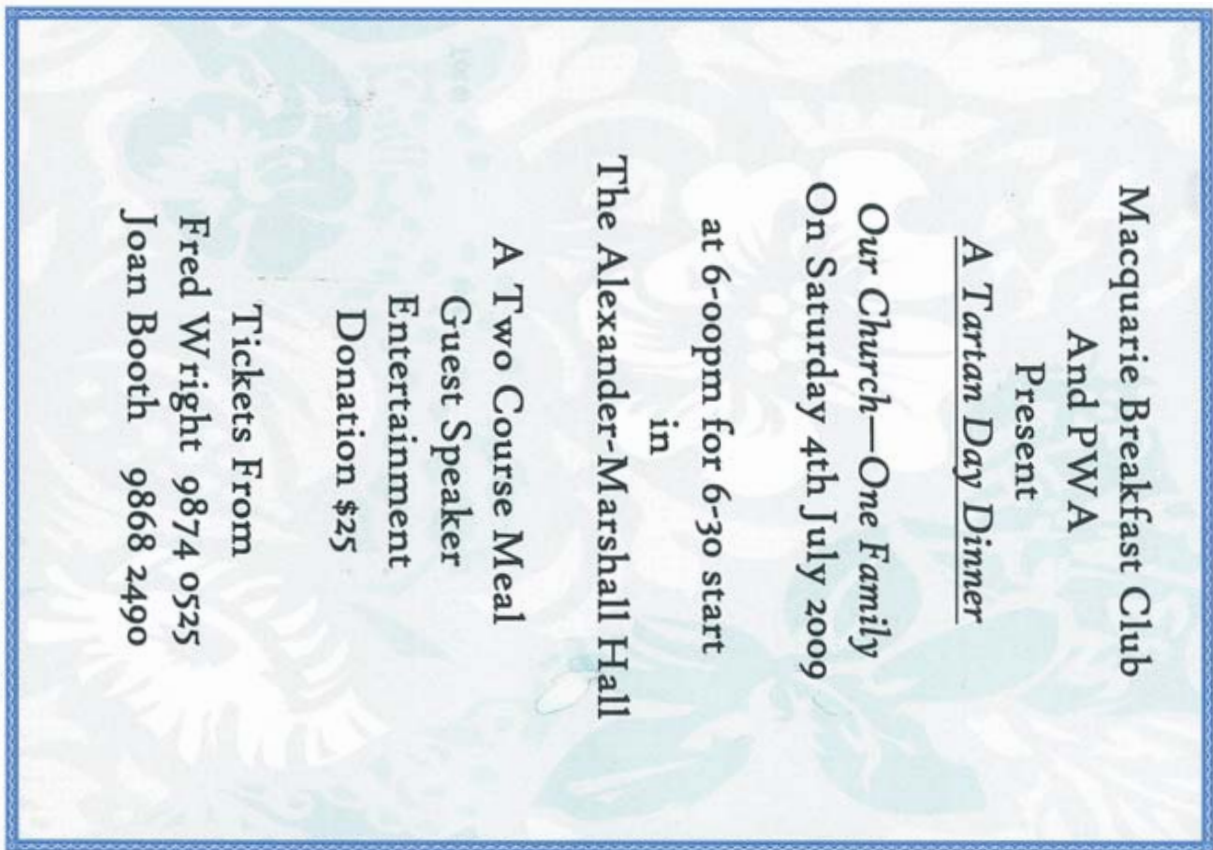
We also congratulate Karl and Diana Robertson on the birth of their baby daughter Beatrice Sandra, also born on Tuesday!
