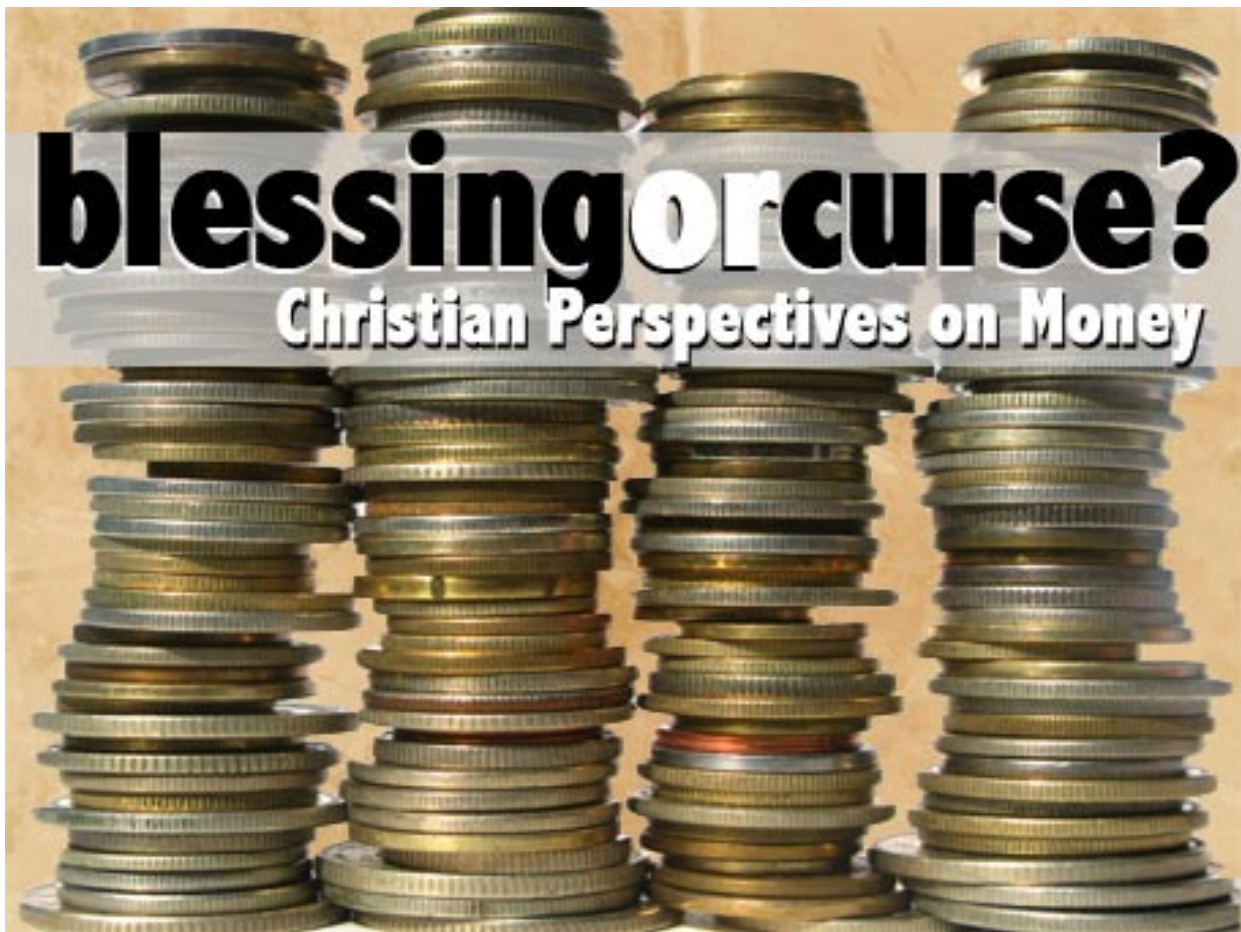
## RE:MAC & WORD FOR LIFE

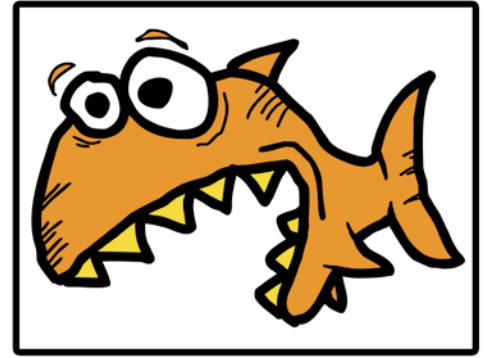
