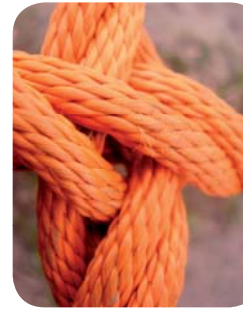

If you are new to church or have not been involved in a small group so far this year - now is a great time to join! Talk to Gayle or write that you are interested on a connect card and she will get in touch.

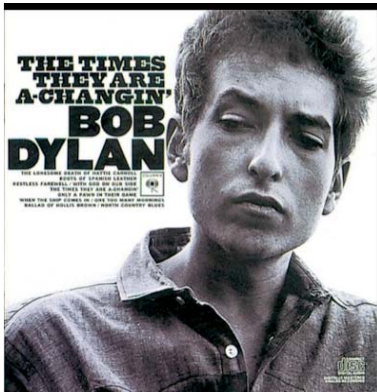


Small groups meet weekly or fortnightly to share life together, discuss the sermon series and spend time in prayer. Being part of a small group is a great way to connect with others at Macchap!

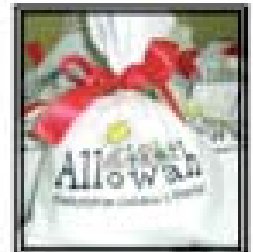
