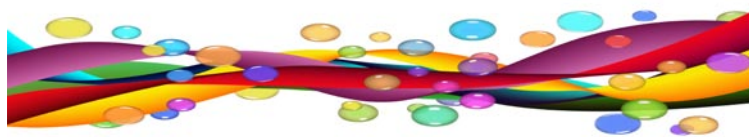

MacMUMS:

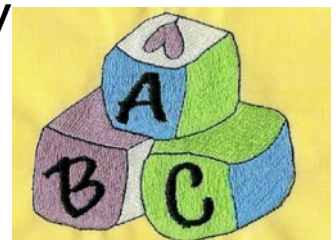
Need to get out of the house? Come and join other mums and their babies at MacMums, an informal time to get together, share and encourage. Bring your own toys, snacks etc.

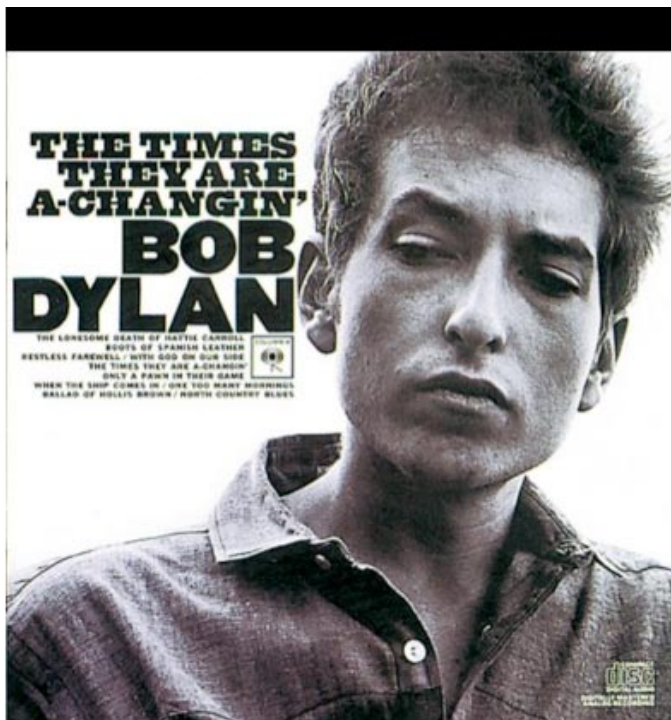
