THE LORD'S PRAYER

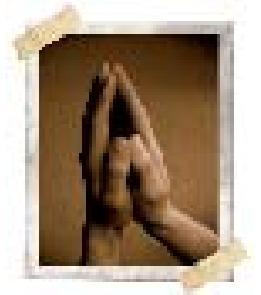
Our Father, who art (is) in heaven,
