exceeding joy.

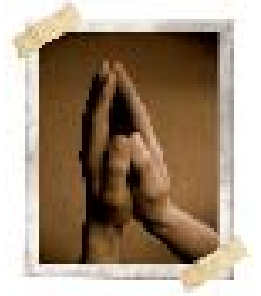
