- no organ at 8.30am – just voices
- no data projection.

## THE LORD'S PRAYER

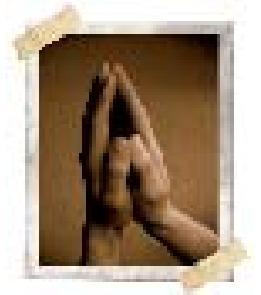
Our Father, who art (is) in heaven,
